RIVER INTAKE PUMP STATION

Located in Gladstone, the River Intake pumps untreated water from the Clackamas River to the treatment plant in West Linn.

with a residential-looking façade, high-quality building materials, landscaping, a public water fountain, and acoustic louvers to help reduce noise



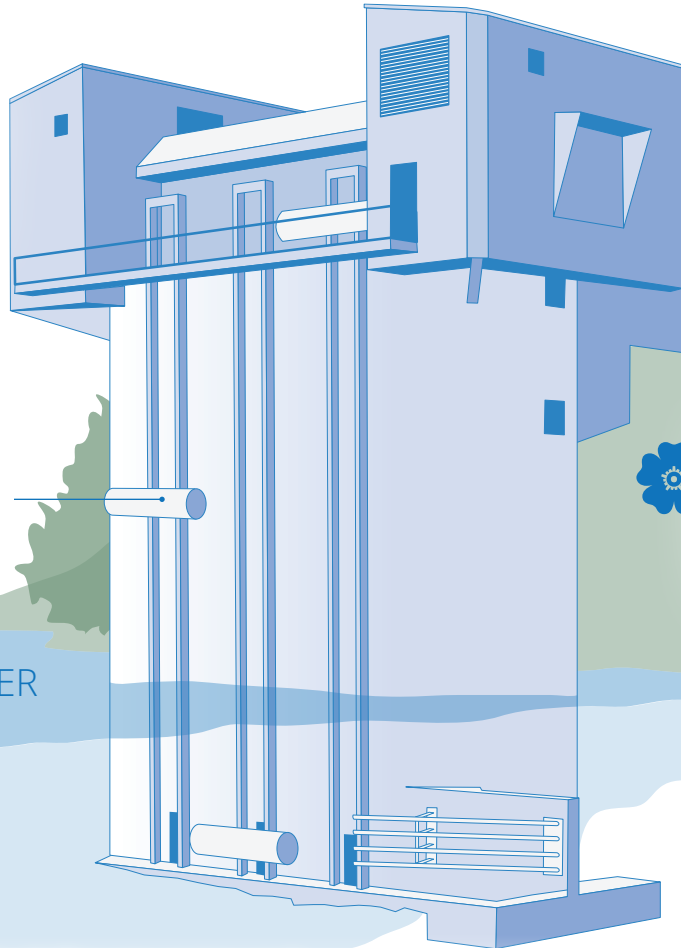
REDUCED ENERGY USE

high efficiency pumps save more than half a million kilowatt hours per year



INTAKE SCREENS

keep fish and debris out of the pumps, can be lifted above the 500-year flood level



PLANTING AND RESTORATION

invasive species were removed from Cross Park and 47 trees and 168 shrubs were planted



SEISMICALLY SOUND

designed to withstand a Cascadia subduction zone earthquake
